 - Sunday Doubles League and 5 and Under League
- Will offer one "late start" 8pm league per week (Thursday)

- Fees:
 - \$190 for first league; \$120 for 2nd and subsequent leagues
 - \$120 for students
 - o If a league has 28 players (7 teams) a \$25 refund to be issued to players on the bottom team who do not play in the final week
