1. 2024/25 Financial highlights
 - a. Started the year with \$81,000 in cash; ended with \$121,000 in cash
 - b. Generated \$33,000 in revenue bonspiels/special events

Bonspiel Update (Todd Shelton)

1. Patriot Spiel has been rebranded to the Oktoberfest Spiel; to be held Oct 17-19
 - a. Holding space for 3 internal teams (3 or more CCCC members); teams with 2 CCCC members and 2 outside members will not be considered internal
2. We will be hosting the GLCA Women's Club Championships Jan 23-25
3. Shamrock Spiel will be held Mar 13-15
4. We will be hosting the 5&U Indiana Stones spiel again Mar 27-29, but it won't be a GLCA event or a national qualifier

Youth Program Update (Geoff Randolph & Todd Shelton)

1. Had a successful first youth program season; took a team to a youth spiel in Detroit and the CCCC team won the "C" event; in addition, another CCCC player filled in on a team from another club that was the other team in the "C" event
