In 2017, The World Curling Federation approved changing the Free Guard rule from 4 stones, to 5. What this means is that any stone delivered prior to the 6th stone shall remain in the Free Guard Zone (FGZ), and can't be removed from play.

As a club, we will be adhering to this change as part of our 2018-2019 season (and going forward).


